Milk Disposal: Please dispose of all milk in the wash racks located between Barn B & Barn A. Do NOT dispose of any milk in the rest rooms or throw on ground.

Manure Disposal: Manure and pen waste can be dumped close to the concrete barrier east of Barn A. Please dump the waste close to the barrier so we have adequate space for driving trailers though to load up animals and tack.

Tape: Only **painters** tape is allowed on any equipment or any of the Fairgrounds facilities. Please do not be using masking tape, scotch tape, duck tape or any other type of tape.

Heat Source: No heat lamps or any type of electrical warming devices are allowed in the barn.
