Entries: All entries will be done online at: <https://showman.app/shows#/colorado-summer-showdown>. To avoid late charges, entry fees must be paid online when entries are submitted unless prior arrangements have been made. **NO REFUNDS.** Refunds will be given to all received entries if the show is canceled due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Registration and Recordation Certificates:

1. Only goats registered with ADGA, AGS, or CGS are eligible to compete. Those goats who have applied for registration with the above organizations may also compete.
2. A registration/recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate showing the date received by ADGA office is required for any animal under 6 months of age. Stamped duplicates are no longer valid after 30 days from official ADGA date stamped on it.
3. A registration certificate or recordation certificate is required for any goat 6 months of age or older.
4. No copies of the registration/recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application shall be accepted by show officials.
5. The document specified above as the requirement of the animal of that age to be shown must have been presented to the show secretary before judging begins.
6. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration/recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate.
7. Information obtained from the ADGA office via telephone, telegram, etc. shall not be accepted in lieu of the document specified above.

Health Requirements: Colorado law requires all out of state goats be accompanied by a valid health certificate. Health certificates will be examined at time of check in. Diseased or injured animals will be removed from the grounds upon recommendation of the show committee. Animals deemed unworthy of competition by the show committee may be barred from competition and removed from the grounds. In such cases, pen and entry fees submitted by owner will be forfeited.

Arrival Times and Check-In: Animals may arrive after noon on Friday June 18th. Exhibitors must be checked in by 9:00pm Friday night (unless prior arrangements have been made).

Show Format: In order to keep the show moving, we will be running four rings at once. The judges will rotate as they complete their breeds and the goats will stay in the same ring. Additionally, the judges will be tasked with placing the top 5 in every class and will only give reasons on the top two. **Bring enough handlers!** We will have four rings going on at once - it is safer to assume that you will have multiple breeds showing at once.

Why a combined Jr/Sr Show: We want to maximize every opportunity ADGA offers to allow your doe to receive a Championship leg. Doing a combined jr/sr sanction allows each breed to have up to two jrs shown to count towards a full unrestricted leg. The additional perk – if you have a stellar jr doe, now you can show her in EIGHT rings! We want every breed sanctioned to go home with 12 Champion legs. Making your efforts and dollars count.

ALL GOATS MUST BE DEHORND OR NATURALLY POLLED.

Milk out at your own discretion - Over-uddered does will be discriminated against.

Base Date: The base date for these shows is June 18, 2021.

Breed Codes: S (Saanen), A (Alpine), T (Toggenburg), L (LaMancha), O (Oberhasli), N (Nubian), D (Nigerian Dwarf), RG (Recorded Grade), AOP (All Other Purebreds).

Jr Division: This division is comprised of doelings under 24 months of age that have never freshened.

Bedding: Please bring your own bedding. No bedding will be available on the fairgrounds.

Penning: Pens must be pre-reserved and will be assigned. Pens are 6x6 with horizontal slats. Please be sure to bring appropriate supplies to ensure kids are unable to escape through the slats. Exhibitors wishing to show off their trailer may do so but please contact the show committee in advance. The show committee reserves the right to limit tack stalls and excessive penning requests in the event the barn nears capacity. Exhibitors will be notified personally if this becomes an issue.

COVID-19: Added safety and sanitation measures will be in place at the show. The Colorado Dairy Goat Association requests all exhibitors to follow all local/state Directed Health Measures and recommendations by the CDC. At this time, that includes 6' social distancing, and masks when social distancing is not practical. At the request of our judges, exhibitors will be **REQUIRED** to wear a mask anytime they are in close physical contact with show staff and judges (I.E. tattoo checks & signing sanction papers.) Exhibitors are asked to bring their own masks for these instances, however disposable masks will be available at the show table if needed. Hand Sanitizer will also be provided at the show table, and there are ample restrooms available for hand washing.

Hold Harmless: Exhibitors and attendees at the show are personally responsible for their own health, safety, and actions. By entering the show, you agree to hold the Colorado Dairy Goat Association, Riverdale Regional Park, and Adams County Fair Board, along with their individual and respective employees, members, directors, sponsors, and heirs harmless from and against any and all costs, expenses, damages, claims, lawsuits, judgments, losses, and/or liabilities (including attorney fees) arising either directly or indirectly from or related to any and all claims made by or against any of the released parties due to bodily injury, death, loss of use, monetary loss, or any other injury from or related to my attendance at the show whether caused by the negligence of the released parties or otherwise. This includes potential damages directly and/or indirectly related to the COVID-19 virus.
