Sr. Doe: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, Nigerian Dwarf & All other Purebred  
Jr. Doe-Alpine: LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade & All other Purebred

ENTRIES: Send entries to Linda Johnson, 1781 Riverside Dr., Laramie, Wyoming, 82070. Postmarked no later than **August 24, 2010** or a late fees of \$10.00 will be charged. **NOTICE:** Any person interfering with the ADGA Judge or Show Committee and/or disrupting the show will be dismissed from the show ring or the fairgrounds, and can be denied show privileges next year.

## REGISTRATION AND RECORDATION CERTIFICATES:

1. Only goats registered with ADGA, AGS, or CGS; or that has applied for registration with these organizations are eligible to compete.
2. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and this **MUST** be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show
3. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age and this **MUST** be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show
4. No copies of the registration/recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
5. Only the I.D. on the registration/recordation certificate or on the stamped duplicate application is proof on ownership.

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

Colorado: Animals originating in state do not need a health certificate. Out-of-state: Animals originating out-of-state who are entering for the purpose of exhibition only, may enter with a health certificate listing your scrapies ID# and stating that the herd of origin is free of caseous lymphadenitis. Those entering for the purpose of sale or purchased, must have been tested negative for Brucellosis and Tuberculosis within 30 days prior to entry in addition to the health certificate. All goats will be carefully examined upon arrival for evidence of infectious or contagious disease, and if such is found they will be held in quarantine and treated at owner's expense. Diseased or injured animals will be removed from the grounds upon recommendation of show committee. Animals deemed unworthy of competition by the show committee may be barred from competition and removed from the grounds. In such cases, the entry & pen fees will be forfeited.

## **ALL GOATS MUST BE DEHORNED OR NATURALLY POLLED**

FEED & BEDDING: Will **NOT** be available.

CLIPPING: Since this show is late in the season, clipping is optional and left up to the discretion of the exhibitor. The judge will not discriminate against any animal or exhibitor in how the animal is clipped or not clipped.

ARRIVAL TIMES: Animals may arrive at any time after Noon on Friday. Show officials will be on hand from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM Friday to check in paperwork. All goats must be in place by 8 p.m. Friday for the Saturday show and by 8 p.m. Saturday for the Sunday show. **THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES MADE IN ANY BREED AFTER THAT BREED HAS BEEN CALLED INTO THE SHOWRING!** NO show milkout. Exhibitors may milk out at their own discretion.

CHAMPION CHALLENGE: Permanent Champions may show in either the regular or Challenge class, whichever the owner chooses. The Grand Champion of the same show must show in the class, and the winner of it shall be called the Best of Breed. If the Grand Champion of the day does not win this class, she will not compete in the Best In Show class, and the winner of the Challenge Championship shall be the Prefix CH or GCH as affixed by ADGA to the animal's registration/recordation. **AN ANIMAL WINNING GRAND CHAMPION IN SHOWS WITHOUT CHAMPION CHALLENGE, OR BEST OF BREED WHERE CHAMPION CHALLENGE IS CONTESTED WILL FORFEIT THE CHAMPION LEG EARNED THAT SHOW IF THEY FAIL TO COMPETE IN THE BEST OF SHOW CLASS.**

CLASSES: The base date for this show is September 11, 2010. All animals shown in-group classes **MUST** have been shown in their regular classes.

BREED CODES: A(Alpine), L(LaMancha), N(Nubian), O (Oberhasli), AOP(All Other Purebreds), RG(Recorded Grades), ND(Nigerian Dwarf).

GROUP CLASSES: All animals must have been shown in their age classes or Champion Challenges. All breeds compete together

**SHOWMANSHIP:** Years of age as of January 1. Classes start at 8:00 AM Saturday & Sunday.

**Pee Wee:** 7 years and under. This class is for fun only and does not qualify for CDGA youth awards, no charge.

**Junior:** 8-10 Years of age

**Intermediate:** 11-13

**Creative Basket Rules:**

1. must be in place by 10:00 on Saturday
2. must be in an appropriate container
3. present a clear theme
4. must be goat related
5. goat item does not have to be homemade(example-cheese can be store bought)
6. minimum of 4 items one of which is the container
7. value of basket not to exceed \$40.00

Ideas: If basket is a spaghetti kit to make it goat related some goat cheese could included. If the basket is a garden theme it could include goat ornaments.

**Candy Contest Rules:**

1. must be in place by 10:00 on Saturday
2. must be made with goat milk
3. recipe must be provided (will be published in CDGA newsletter at a later date).
4. entry to be a ¼ pound

**Cake Decorating Contest Rules:**

1. must be in place by 10:00 on Saturday
2. it can be any type of cake
3. decorations must be a goat theme
4. cakes will be silently auctioned off

**CAMPING-**Camping is permitted only at the campgrounds. You can reach the Campground Host at 303-678-1525 for reservations and fees.
